

7. 2 photos in the white background (3.5cm×4.5cm) - Write students' name on the back.

※ Documents written in languages other than Korean or English must include attachments of its translation in Korean or English.

◆ **Deadline:** January 22, 2013 (if the documents will be arrived later than deadline, please contact us in advance)

◆ **Insurance**

1. Students must purchase insurance, and submit it upon their arrival.

2. If students want to purchase insurance in Republic of Korea, the fee is approximately 150,000 ~ 200,000 KRW per year.

3. The insurance purchased in Korea covers costs associated with regular treatment at hospital, medicine, surgery, hospitalization (note: the insurance does not cover dental and cosmetic procedures)

◆ **Residence Hall**

1. Fee: Approximately 950,000 KRW/semester (for the new BTL dormitory)

2. Facilities

- Two persons in a room.

- Provision of three meals a day (except Saturdays and Sundays)

\* notice : The fee includes management expense and meal expense, and devided payment is not allowed. Students can eat 3 meals a day in dormitory cafeteria, and personally cannot cook in dormitory in order to prevent fire.

- Each room is furnished with a desk, chair, air conditioner, bed, wardrobe, telephone, bathroom, broadband

- You will need to provide your own blanket and pillows, as well as toiletry (soap, towel, etc.)

- Other Facilities: Reading room, Computer Hall, Laundry Room, Ironing Room, Convenient Store, AV Room

3. Dormitory Fee(USD 850) has to be paid to the dormitory bank account before students leave their home country. The payment date and bank account will be announced hereafter.
